BOARD INFORMATION

Whole Person Health Ministry:

- Our usual 3rd Sunday Blood Pressure Screening will be on the 3rd Sundays over the summer: **July 15** and **August 19th**. While we strive to keep the monthly screening on 3rd Sundays, when we are away, or the date falls on a holiday as in Father's Day in June, we reschedule. Please watch for our publication of dates each month.
- **Summer Blood Drive: Carter Blood will have their Mobile Van parked on our front drive on Sunday, August 12th and will accept donations between 12 noon and 2:30 pm.** While waiting your turn feel welcome to come in to the Parish Hall for light refreshments before your turn in the van. A sign-up sheet will be posted on the WPHM Bulletin Board by July 15th, so you may reserve your time.

- **Family and Friends CPR class will be held in the Parish Hall on Sunday, August 5th**, following Divine Service. We can accommodate up to 12. Please sign up on the bulletin board in the narthex. The class will begin as soon as possible (12:15 hopefully) and will last 3 hours. You will receive a book with a participation card attached.

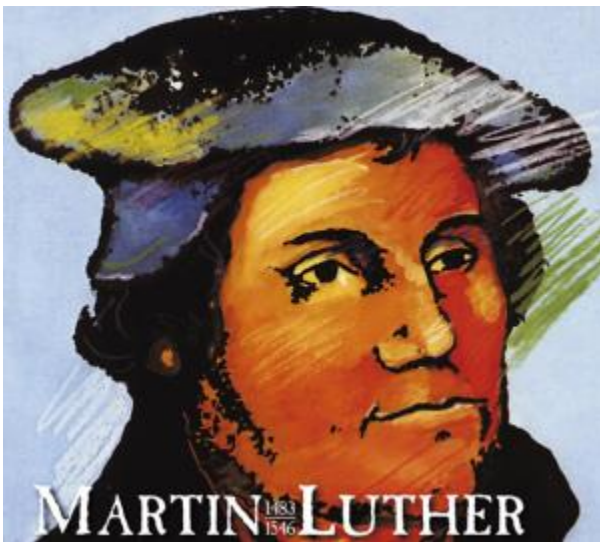

Our Active God



Therefore, let us learn this rule and order which God is wont to employ in governing His saints. For I, too, have often attempted to prescribe to God definite methods He should use in the administration either of the church or of other matters. “Ah, Lord,” I have said, “I would like this to be done in this order, with this result!” But God would do the very opposite of what I had sought. Then the thought would come to me: “Nevertheless, my plan is not disadvantageous to the glory of God; but it will contribute very much toward the hallowing of Thy name, the gathering and increasing of Thy kingdom, and the propagation of the knowledge of Thy Word. In short, it is a very fine plan and excellently thought out.” But the Lord undoubtedly laughed at this wisdom and said: “Come now, I know that you are a wise and learned man; but it has never been My custom for Peter, Dr. Martin, or anyone else to teach, direct, govern, and lead Me. I am not a passive God. No, I am an active God who is accustomed to do the leading, ruling, and directing.
